Program Details

Our Summer English Language Camp is designed for children & teens who want to live in Toronto, improve their English, make friends from around the world, and visit exciting tourist destinations. Students will experience unforgettable memories to last a lifetime!

Students will attend daily morning English classes, and participate in daily afternoon trips around the city of Toronto. Led by our teachers, the trips are a fun way for students to see the city with their classmates, meet students from other countries around the world, and practice speaking English at the same ! Beyond daily English classes and activities, students participate in a full-day trip every Saturday to Niagara Falls, Canada's Wonderland, and Wasaga Beach. On all activities students are expected to speak English only.

FULL PACKAGE includes:

- » 3 hours of daily English instruction (Monday to Friday)
 - » Homestay accommodation (private room, 3 meals/day, packed lunch)
 - » Daily afternoon trips & activities, including all entrance fees (Monday to Friday)
 - » a full day trip every Saturday (Niagara Falls, Canada's Wonderland, Wasaga Beach)
 - » Airport pick-up & drop-off
 - » Medical Insurance
 - » All materials, Certificate of Completion, Graduation Ceremony
 - » All registration and placement fees
 - » Notarized Canadian Guardian documentation
- Not included: daily transportation costs (students must purchase subway/bus tickets or pass)*

The Partial Package includes all features of the Full Package, except for Homestay, airport pick-up & drop-off.

Location

Summer camp classes are held in downtown Toronto at St. Vladimir Institute (a 10-minute walk from our main location). The school is located at 620 Spadina Avenue surrounded by the University of Toronto buildings. Our facility has air-conditioned classrooms, a student area with a ping-pong table, vending machines for juice and pop, and refrigerators to keep lunches cold. The school is a five-minute walk from Spadina subway station. Host families will show students how to get to school the first day.

Students

Our students come from a number of countries around the world including: Russia, Korea, Spain, Japan, Venezuela, Brazil, Saudi Arabia, Switzerland, and more. All students are expected to speak in English at all times.

Accommodation

Most students live in **Homestay** accommodation with Canadian families. Homestay hosts provide three meals per day which include a packed lunch to take to school. Homes are located within 45 minutes by public transportation to the school. All host families have been carefully screened by our Homestay Coordinator to ensure our students' comfort and safety. Students under the age of 12 will be placed in a homestay with an older student who will accompany them to school, or will be driven to school daily by their host family (*additional fee applies*).

We can arrange residence accommodation (for groups only) at various private residences which are close to the school. Additional charges apply. Please contact ACCESS for details and costs if you are interested in this option.

Program Details

Location

Parents' classes will be held at our school's main location in downtown Toronto. The school is a 1-minute walk from Yonge/Bloor subway station and is surrounded by restaurants, movie theatres, and office buildings. **Children & Teens classes** will be held at our Summer Camp location (a 10-15 minute walk from our main location).

Escort

Parents & children will arrive at ACCESS' main location every morning. Our staff will personally escort the children to our Summer camp location. After lunch, parents will come to our Summer Camp to meet their children and join the day's trip. Parents not participating in trips must pick their children up at our Summer camp after school (at 4pm).

Trips & Activities

Children and teens will participate in a trip or activity everyday as well as a full day trip every Saturday (see “Summer Camp Program details” for further information). Parents have the option of joining their children on trips and activities (extra charges apply). Contact ACCESS for further details.

Accommodation

Homestay

Many parents & their children choose to stay in a Homestay with Canadian families. Homestay hosts provide three meals per day which include a packed lunch to take to school. Families are located within 45 minutes from the school.
