Experience Real Canadian Winter Activities

Program Details

Experience the magic of winter in Toronto! Our Winter English Language Camp is designed for teens who want to experience what it's like to live in Toronto, improve their English abilities, make friends from around the world, visit exciting tourist destinations, and participate in authentic & fun Canadian winter sports.

Students will attend daily morning English classes, and participate in daily afternoon trips and activities around the city of Toronto. Led by our teachers, the trips are a fun way for students to see the city with their classmates, meet students from other countries around the world, and practice speaking English at the same! Many of our trips will have a "Canadian winter" theme, in order to introduce our students to Canadian winter experiences.

Students participate in a full-day trip every Saturday to Niagara Falls, as well as skiing & snowboarding at a nearby ski resort.

FULL PACKAGE includes:

- » 3 hours of daily English instruction (Monday to Friday)
 - » Homestay accommodation (private room, 3 meals/day, packed lunch)
 - » Daily afternoon trips & activities, including all entrance fees (Monday to Friday)
 - » a full day trip/ activity every Saturday experiencing typical Canadian winter activities
 - » Airport pick-up & drop-off
 - » Medical Insurance
 - » All materials, Certificate of Completion, Graduation Ceremony
 - » All registration and placement fees
 - » Notarized Canadian Guardian documentation
- Not included: daily transportation costs (students must purchase subway/bus tickets or pass)*

Classes

Daily English classes are exciting and fun! Students will learn speaking, listening, reading, writing, grammar, pronunciation & conversation skills. Teachers are dynamic and engaging and use the communicative method in classes in order to motivate young learners. There is an average of 10 students in each class.

Make Friends From Around The World

Our students come from a number of countries around the world including: Russia, Korea, Spain, Japan, Venezuela, Brazil, Saudi Arabia, Switzerland, and more. All students are expected to speak in English at all times both inside the school and on all school trips & activities.

Accommodation

Students live in **Homestay** accommodation with Canadian families. Homestay hosts provide three meals per day which include a packed lunch to take to school. Homes are located an average of 25 - 30 minutes by public transportation to the school. All host families have been carefully screened by our Homestay Coordinator to ensure our students' comfort and safety.

Join your classmates and teachers on daily trips & activities around Toronto & Ontario. Every afternoon we will head to a different tourist destination or try a fun Canadian winter sports activity. Trips & Activities have been specially chosen to introduce students to Canadian winter activities such as; skiing, snowboarding, dog sledding, snowshoeing, snow tubing, curling, and skating. Every Saturday students will join in full-day ski & snowboarding trips, as well as a day-trip to Niagara Falls. Don't worry if you haven't tried some of these activities before. All activities will start off with a lesson, so you can feel comfortable giving it a try. Your teachers will be there to help you, and make sure you have fun too!

Our trips & activities are a great way to enjoy Toronto and experience the magic of winter with your new friends.

Important Note:

- If possible, students should arrive & depart on Saturdays.
- Students will receive one less full-day Saturday trip than the total # of weeks of studies. I.e: One week program = no Saturday trip, 2 weeks program = 1 Saturday trip, 3 weeks program = 2 Saturday trips, 4 weeks program = 5 Saturday trips.
- While we attempt to run all activities as scheduled, from time to time, scheduled activities may change due to factors such as weather, scheduling, etc. Note: all transportation is included. Skiing/Snowboarding equipment rental & lift ticket is included, as well as a lesson for beginners. All other equipment for activities is included (ie: curling brooms & rocks, snowshoes, dog sleds, ice skates).



Start Dates

The program runs from November to March and has weekly start dates (every Monday).
